## Associated Koi Clubs of America Comes to Town to Hold its' Annual Business Meeting and Wet Lab

What's a Wet Lab? Many Wet Labs only involve dissecting a koi and some general instruction about what to look for. The gill plate will be cut off so you can see the gills, or lamellae. Healthy gills will have the red color of a steak. Then there's a cut from the vent to the gills, but instead of removing the insides like you would before you fry a trout, another cut is made from the vent to the

dorsal fin. Then the side of the fish is folded or removed at the top of the fish and you can see all of the internal organs. Pretty cool and pretty disgusting all at the same time.

Some Wet Labs, like the AKCA one we're about to host, take the wet part a little further. Using microscopes, they'll teach us how to look for parasites from live koi. We'll be scraping a small amount of slime coat from various parts of the koi and use the microscope to look for the bad guys living in the goo.

As a KHA Student I can only think, "Gee, what fun!" If you're not a KHA Student, you can still experience this stuff up close and gooey, for a modest \$25 fee. Call Jean Jahr to reserve your spot. Not interested in getting wet or gooey? You can watch from the sidelines where you can still see and hear much of what's going on. There's no fee to just observe.



This is my entry (below/right), hanging out in the Q tank with some of the pond spawn. His name is Archie (Ochiba)


He was measured at 7 ¾" in March. I think he's somewhere between 9 & 10 inches now.
